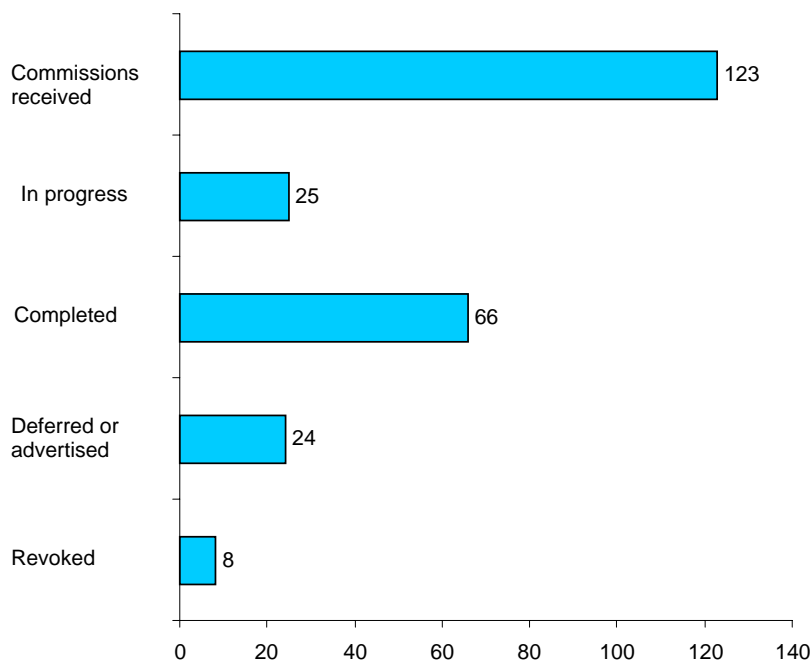


IQWiG in numbers – 2004 to 2009 (status: 12/09)

Commissions

Since its establishment, the Institute has received a total of 123 commissions. The German Federal Joint Committee has revoked 8 of these commissions, 24 have been deferred or are currently advertised. 66 commissions have already been completed. Another 25 commissions are currently in progress.

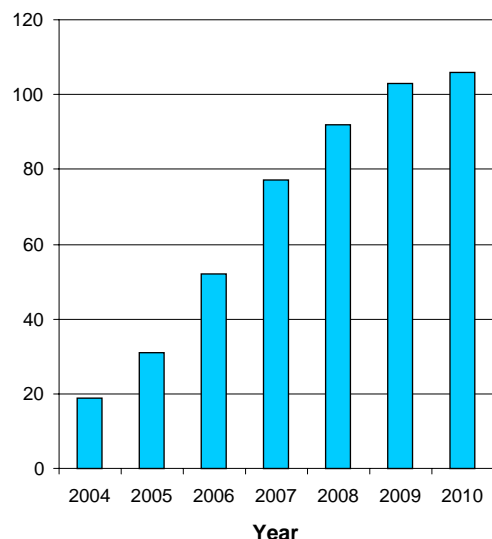


This year, a total of 29 commissions were completed, and 10 preliminary benefit assessments (preliminary reports) and 7 report plans were published. In addition, the Federal Joint Committee awarded 8 new commissions.

Staff

In October 2004, 11 employees commenced work at IQWiG; by the end of 2004, a further 8 had been recruited. Approximately 100 employees are currently working at the Institute, 61 of which are scientific staff members and 13 department heads. An additional 3 positions are planned for 2010.

No. of employees

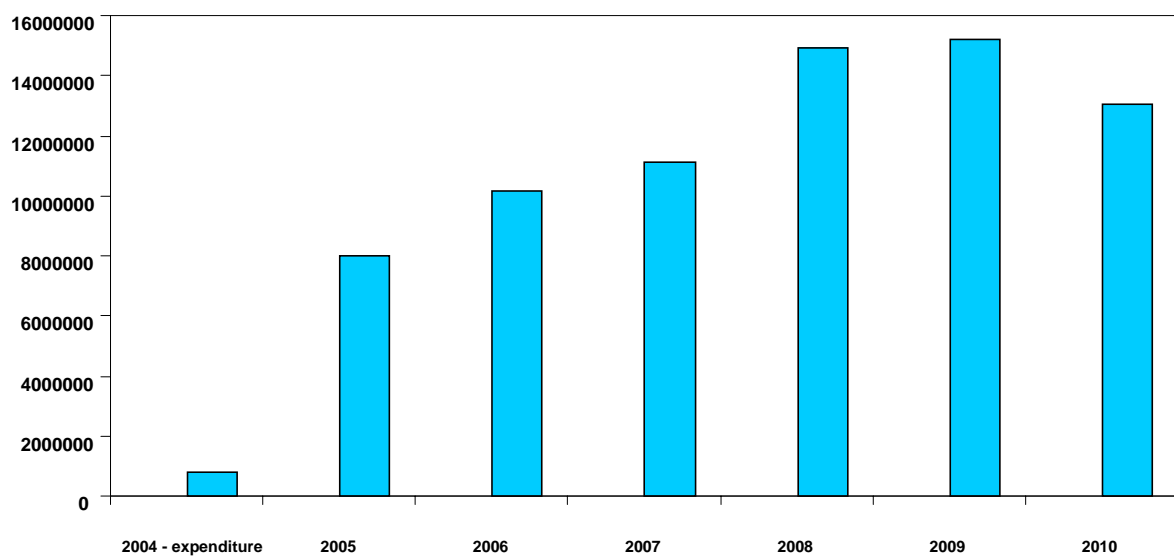


Finances

A budget of about 8 million euros was set by the Foundation Council in 2005, and by 2009 this had reached some 15 million euros. In 2010 the budget will be slightly smaller at 13 million euros.

The budget covers not only staff salaries and running costs, but also expenditure on external experts.
